SCHOLARSHIPS: Up to five \$2,000 Scholarships will be Awarded

ELIBILITY: Any full-time graduate or undergraduate student enrolled in a degree program majoring in Plant Sciences or a related field (plant production, turfgrass, urban forestry, landscape architecture, entomology, plant pathology, landscape design, etc.) at a South Carolina educational institution. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

CRITERIA: The SC Green Board of Directors will determine the scholarship winners based on (1) academics, (2) related extra-curricular activities, and (3) work history and career goals.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Complete a Scholarship Application (print or type answers on 8 ½” x 11” paper)
- Include a current transcript that shows at least the previous, full semester.
- Include a short biography that includes a statement of career goals.
